You look at the part and its serial number, look it up in the computer system and perform a visual check for damage, dents or other defects. You accurately record all relevant data.

Based on your assessment, you determine if the part is suitable for repair. Suitable pieces are forwarded to an external repair service and reused for the fabrication of new parts. You work with a hoist and an electric pallet, making lifting heavy pieces efficient and easy.

- You are a motivated employee who likes to roll up your sleeves. Getting a little dirty is not a problem for you.
- You enjoy working independently and know how to proactively make adjustments where necessary.
- You can work at a fast pace and attach great importance to delivering quality.
